Because of these challenges, Joel was at risk of dropping out of school. With the support of a SAAS scholarship, however, he has been able to continue his education and remain focused on his future goals.

Joel performs particularly well in Mathematics, Science, and English, and is determined to work hard to achieve his dream of becoming an engineer. Outside the classroom, he enjoys playing football during his free time.
