Because of these constraints, Thomas has frequently been sent home for school fees, missing important lessons for days at a time. Despite these setbacks, he has remained committed to his studies and continues to register good academic results.

The support provided through a SAAS scholarship has renewed Thomas's hope and determination, allowing him to remain in school consistently and focus on achieving his academic goals. He particularly enjoys Mathematics, Physics, and Geography—subjects closely aligned with his aspiration to become a civil engineer.
